# 2. Administration Report - Principal David Howell

- Events / Dates:
  - February Black History Month
  - Feb 1 Kindergarten Open House
  - **Feb 15 Report cards go home:** Parents are encouraged to maintain a growth mindset and to communicate goals with teachers.
  - **Feb 16 PA Day -** Topics: Strategic planning on "Belonging"; EQAO; Indigenous education; phonics; health and safety training for staff.
  - June 26: Grade 8 Graduation
  - Safe and Accepting Schools Webpage available via DSBN website re: Anti-bullying
    - Educating on difference between bullying and conflict, 95% of bullying is solved via problem solving protocol or staff intervention.
  - NEW: Gymnastics Program (bench & floor) Grades 4-8, boys and girls.
  - Outdoor Classroom project, next phase is outdoor classroom with green space.
    - \$500 granted from new superintendent following student presentation.
    - Students submitted proposal for TD grant.

## 3. Finance - Balance: \$7,248.56

- Balance after pending withdrawals: \$6,750.79
- Popcorn Sales: Averaging \$160/day.
- Hot Chocolate: Brought in \$169, less \$53 for supplies (and leftovers).
